CLOSING DATE: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 28, 2021, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

ENTRY FEES: TD - \$60.00. A \$.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH 11, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. Make checks payable to **RBTF**, **Inc**.

ELIGIBILITY: Test is limited to **5** dogs with appropriate Certification or have previously passed a TD or TDU test. Each entry for a dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD/TDU test must be accompanied by a written statement, dated within one year of the date of the test, signed by a person approved by the AKC to judge tracking tests, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.

ENTRY DRAWING: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will be held to determine the participants in the test. The drawing will be held on **Thursday**, **January 28**, **2021 at 6:15 p.m.**, at **Starbucks Coffee**, **2000 El Camino Real**, **Palo Alto CA 94306**.

The order of draw shall be in accordance with **Chapter 1, Section 13** of the Tracking Regulations. This Test is open to all AKC-registerable breeds of dogs as per the section above, however, the draw for entries will be done for the respective tests in the following order:

- 1 Belgian Tervuren without a TD/TDU
- 2 Belgian Tervuren with a TD/TDU
- 3 Other breeds without a TD/TDU
- 4 Other breeds with a TD/TDU

ALTERNATE LIST: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

NOTIFICATION: Notification of the draw results will be made by email as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

REFUND POLICY: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

VACCINATIONS: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

ARBITRATION: This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

TEST HOURS: 6:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Judging will begin as soon as tracks have aged sufficiently.

DRAWING FOR RUNNING ORDER - All dogs and handlers must be at the test area by the designated time **8:30 a.m. Sunday, February 7, 2021**, at which time there will be a draw to determine the running order. Entrants not present at the time of the draw will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

AWARDS: A dark green qualifying rosette, and a photograph will be awarded to each passing team, and also a photo+frame.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate in the test. Handlers are asked to park well away from the other vehicles and to notify the Secretary that your entered bitch is in season. They will be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. The last track will be for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, there will be a separate draw for these bitches.

DOGS ON LEASH: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the bench show Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim against RBTF and its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. RBTF assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person; theft of personal property; theft, injury or death of any animal; or any loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site or in transit to/from the site.

COMPETING UNDER YOUR TRACKING BUDDY - NEW TEN DAY RULES:

- No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has
 participated in a training session taught by that judge within thirty (30) ten (10) days
 prior to the date of the event. (AKC Tracking Regulations, January 1, 2021, Chapter
 1, Section 12, pg. 4)
- People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past 30-10 days, they have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler. The judges may modify the draw to meet the requirements of the tracklayer. (AKC Tracking Regulations, January 1, 2021, Chapter 2, Section 10, pg. 10)

SITE INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS: From Sacramento, take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Zinfandel Dr. South exit. Continue on Zinfandel Rd until you reach Douglas Rd. Continue straight on Zinfandel Rd through the signal. Go 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. **From Placerville**, take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento and follow the above directions. Tracking test headquarters is under the gazebo at the Mather Field Rotary Park.

Mather land availability has undergone many recent changes. For official purposes, we are allowed to use only the land immediately north of the headquarters, and the strip of land starting at the south east corner of Mather Blvd and Arnold Rd (near the church), extending south to the large ditch, and ending near Convair Liner Rd (interior road with yellow gate). However, it appears that the public continues to access areas of land formerly owned by the park in an unofficial capacity. Use discretion when practicing at the park. Please respect all "No Dogs" posted signs.

SPECTATOR/DRIVING ACCESS. We are no longer officially allowed any vehicle access on any of the interior roads. We will likely need to drive to the west side of the park when staging for some of the tracks, and there is likely to be a significant walk for exhibitors and spectators (if allowed) into and out of the areas. In addition, the area available for exercising dogs during the event has changed - please look for marked area and/or inquire before exercising your dog at the site.

PRACTICING: Limited practicing on the test site is permitted with these restrictions. No training on the grounds is permitted on the day of the test. Please refrain from using the fields at least 3 days before the test. Please respect all "No Dogs" posted signs.

PARKING FEES: Participants and spectators are responsible for payment of all daily parking fees and must observe all parking regulations. Parking regulations are enforced 24 hours, 7 days per week, 365 days per year (including Sundays & holidays). The fee is \$5 per day payable in cash or credit card on site.

COVID-19 BEST PRACTICES

Our goal is to keep everyone as safe as we can. If any exhibitor is sick, know they have been exposed to COVID-19 or uncomfortable with the precautions RBTF is taking, **do not enter**, and stay home. Our mental and physical well-being is most important at all times. Remember when entering a tracking test, it is done at your own risk. If you have not read the Agreement in your entry, you should do so now and be aware of what you are signing.

We will be following the rules and guidelines set forward by our state, county, and local agencies along with CDC and AKC guidelines. Our aim is to keep our judges, volunteers, and exhibitors as safe as possible.

- If you are coming from more than 150 miles away, DON'T ENTER.
- Within 14 days of the test, if you have a cough, sore throat, shortness of breath or problems breathing, fever/chills, muscle pain or a loss of taste or smell, DON'T ENTER.
- Within 14 days of the test, if you come into contact with a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has symptoms listed above, DON'T ENTER.

On test day:

- Masks are REQUIRED when not isolating in your car (bring your own mask). Masks will be
 worn over the nose and mouth at all times. You will be asked to leave the test vicinity if you
 prefer to not wear a mask, your entry fees WILL NOT be refunded.
- Be at test headquarters in person at the time the track draw is scheduled on Sunday morning.
 The draw will be the only time the exhibitors and tracklayers and judges will be together in
 person (please no spectators if this gathering is greater than county guidelines!). At this time
 all participants will be questioned about symptoms and exposure, to validate the agreement
 everyone signed.
- The briefing and draw will be done as quickly as possible, during which time everyone will stand appropriately distanced, and after which we will be returning to waiting in our cars or wherever is appropriate.
- Plan on waiting for your turn in your car when not pottying your dog or other essential activity.
 You will be contacted by phone/text when it is time for you to bring your dog to test
 headquarters, one exhibitor and tracklayer at a time. Please practice social distancing
 consistent with current guidelines. Please make sure the test secretary has your best mobile
 contact number!
- There will be no shared snacks or lunch, sorry!!! Please bring your own. We recommend that you eat in your car. Wash hands as frequently as possible. Bring your own hand sanitizer.
- Leave at least a vehicle or two spaces between your vehicles. There is plenty of parking.
- Avoid gathering, and, to belabor the point: practice distancing. Avoid shaking hands or hugging. Avoid touching dogs that are not yours, as the owner may have kissed their dog. Avoid common use of pens/pencils – bring your own.
- Spectators are welcome and will be reminded to stand distanced when part of the gallery
 watching a track, and are requested to wait in their cars all other times. If we get too many
 spectators in the gallery (more than county guidelines), we reserve the right to ask that some
 spectators remain behind in their cars.

Tracklayers WILL be handling/scenting the articles. If you are uncomfortable handling the articles, please wear disposable/washable gloves (bring your own gloves).

Remember - if you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR you are unwilling to follow our Best Practices, it would be best you do not enter our tests.

COVID-19 RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

By completing and signing an entry for this event, exhibitor agrees to the following:
