**CLOSING DATE:** Entries will be accepted until **Wednesday, January 2, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.**, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$125.00. A \$.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH 13, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations.

Make checks payable to **RBTF, Inc.** and mail to the Trial Secretary. **Receipt of entry will be sent if a legible email address is provided on the entry form.**

**TEST ELIGIBILITY:** Test is limited to 4 dogs who have previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test.

**BREED ELIGIBILITY:** Dogs must be an AKC-registered purebred or in one of the following categories: dogs registered with an AKC Limited Registration number, or dogs with a PAL (Purebred Alternative Listing) or ILP (Indefinite Listing Privilege) number. The AKC Limited Registration number, PAL or ILP number must be shown on the entry form. A dog approved for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows and a dog of a Foundation Stock Service recorded breed that meets the eligibility requirements for competition are eligible to compete provided their AKC identification number appears on the entry form.

**ENTRY DRAWING:** A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will be held to determine the participants in the test. The drawing will be held on **Wednesday, January 2, 2019 at 7:30 p.m.**, at **Starbucks Coffee**, 6009 Snell Ave (at Santa Teresa), San Jose, CA 95123. The order of draw shall be in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Tracking Regulations. This Test is open to all AKC-registerable breeds of dogs as per the section above, however, the draw for entries will be done for the test in the following order:

- Belgian Tervuren without a VST
- Belgian Tervuren with a VST
- Other breeds without a VST
- Other breeds with a VST

**ALTERNATES:** An alternate list shall be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for the limited entries.

**NOTIFICATION:** The results of the draw will be sent as soon as possible following the draw. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** may participate in the test. Handlers are asked to park well away from the other vehicles and to notify the Secretary that your entered bitch is in season. They will be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. The last track will be for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, there will be a separate draw for these bitches.

**REFUND POLICY:** The entry fee for an entry (provided there is an alternate that participates in the test) or an alternate that does not participate in the test will be refunded within seven days following the test.

**TEST HOURS:** 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

**JUDGING:** Judging will begin as soon as the tracks have aged sufficiently.

**AWARDS:** A dark green rosette and a double-sided 5x7 picture frame will be awarded to all passing dogs.

**LEASHES:** Dogs shall be kept on leash at all times in the area of the tracking test, or on college property. Please pick up after your dogs.

**PARKING FEE:** The daily parking fee is \$2.

**DIRECTIONS:** From Highway 99 south, exit the Cosumnes River College Boulevard exit and go west. Turn left on Bruceville Road. The college will be on your right (high levees surround the entire campus) and enter at the first entrance to the college on your right. When you reach the front of the school, turn right into parking lot #F.

**PRACTICING:** Los Rios Community College District (including Cosumnes River and American River colleges) is actively enforcing a NO DOGS policy on campus at any time, the only exception being graciously made for our VST test competitors during their testing. Please respect this policy so that we will be allowed to continue holding our tests on campus.

**DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the bench show Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim against the Redwood Belgian Tervuren Fanciers Inc and its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

The HEALTH AND SAFETY of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be stopped or cancelled before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people or dogs.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the state of California.

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 13, Section 3.)
