**CLOSING DATE:** Entries will be accepted until Thursday, January 23, 2014, at 6:00 p.m., after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

**ENTRY FEES:** TD - \$50.00, TDX - \$100.00. A \$.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH 11, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. Make checks payable to **RBTF, Inc.** and mail to the Trial Secretary.

**Receipt of entry will be sent if an email address is provided on the entry form.**

**TD ELIGIBILITY:** Test is limited to 4 dogs with appropriate Certification or have previously passed a TD test. Each entry for a dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD test must be accompanied by a written statement, dated within one year of the date of the test, signed by a person approved by the AKC to judge tracking tests, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.

**TDX ELIGIBILITY:** TDX entry is limited to 2 dogs that have previously passed a TD or TDX test. See entry drawing order below.

**EXCHANGE of TRACKS:** If the limit for all-breed entries is not reached in either the TD or TDX test and the other is exceeded, the number of tracks offered may be exchanged on the basis of two (2) TD tracks for one (1) TDX track (to a maximum of 8 TD or 4 TDX).

**BREED ELIGIBILITY:** Dogs must be an AKC-registered purebred or in one of the following categories: dogs registered with an AKC Limited Registration number, or dogs with a PAL (Purebred Alternative Listing) or ILP (Indefinite Listing Privilege) number. The AKC Limited Registration number, PAL or ILP number must be shown on the entry form. A dog approved for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows and a dog of a Foundation Stock Service recorded breed that meets the eligibility requirements for competition are eligible to compete provided their AKC identification number appears on the entry form.

**ENTRY DRAWING:** A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will be held to determine the participants in the test. The drawing will be held on Thursday, January 23, 2014 at 7:00 p.m., at Starbucks Coffee, **5873 Antelope Rd, Ste 100, Sacramento, CA 95842-3902.**

The order of draw shall be in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Tracking Regulations. This Test is open to all AKC-registerable breeds of dogs as per the section above, however, the draw for entries will be done for the respective tests in the following order:

- 1 – Belgian Tervuren without a TD/TDX
- 2 – Belgian Tervuren with a TD/TDX
- 3 – Other breeds without a TD/TDX
- 4 – Other breeds with a TD/TDX

**ALTERNATES:** An alternate list shall be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw.

Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for the limited entries.

**NOTIFICATION:** The results of the draw will be sent as soon as possible following the draw. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** may participate in the test. Handlers are asked to park well away from the other vehicles and to notify the Secretary that your entered bitch is in season. They will be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. The last track will be for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, there will be a separate draw for these bitches.

**REFUND POLICY:** The entry fee for an entry (provided there is an alternate that participates in the test) or an alternate that does not participate in the test will be refunded within seven days following the test.

**TEST HOURS:** 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

**DRAWING FOR RUNNING ORDER** - All dogs and handlers must be at the test area by the designated times shown below on **Sunday, February 2, 2014**, at which time there will be a draw to determine the running order. Entrants not present at the time of the draw will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

TD – 7:30 a.m.

TDX – 10:00 a.m.

**JUDGING:** Judging will begin as soon as the tracks have aged sufficiently.

**AWARDS:** A dark green rosette and a metal dog water bottle will be awarded to all passing dogs.

**LEASHES:** Dogs shall be kept on leash at all times in the area of the tracking test, or on park property. Please pick up after your dogs.

**RABIES CERTIFICATE:** Since this is Sacramento County Parks property, please have a copy of your dog's current rabies vaccination with you at all times.

**PARKING FEE:** Parking lot requires a daily use fee of **\$5.00** per car per day. Please pay as you enter the parking lot.

**CELL PHONE CONTACT:** To contact the Test Secretary the weekend of the test - **(916) 826-8378**. Please do not use this number at other times.

**DIRECTIONS: From Sacramento,** take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Zinfandel Dr. South exit. Continue on Zinfandel Rd until you reach Jackson Rd. At this point Zinfandel becomes Eagles Nest Rd. Continue straight on Eagles Nest Rd. Go 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. **From Placerville,** take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento and follow the above directions. Tracking test headquarters is under the gazebo.

**PRACTICING:** Practicing on the test site is permitted. The areas we are allowed to use are anything on the right after you turn onto Eagles Nest all the way to Woodring Rd. Please do not use the area on the right beyond Woodring and anything on the left, as dogs are no longer allowed in those areas. Please refrain from using the fields at least 3 days before the test. No training on the grounds is permitted on the day of the test.

**DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the bench show Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim against the Redwood Belgian Tervuren Fanciers and its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

The HEALTH AND SAFETY of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be stopped or cancelled before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people or dogs.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the state of California.

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
