**TEST LIMIT: VST** entry is limited to three (3) dogs. TDU entry is limited to three (3) dogs.

ENTRY FEE: VST entry fee is \$150.00 payable in US dollars. TDU entry fee is \$75.00 payable in US dollars. Fees include \$4.50 AKC recording fee. Make checks payable to RBTF, Inc.

**DRAW FOR ENTRY:** A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be at 7:30 PM on Friday, January 2, 2026 at Starbucks, 2000 El Camino Real, Palo Alto CA 94306.

The order of the draw shall be in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Tracking Regulations. This test is open to all AKC registered dogs as per the section above, however, the draw for entries will be done for the tests in the following order:

**DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER:** All entrants must be at their respective test sites for the draw for their test at which time there will be a draw for the running order for that test. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

TDU Draw: 7:45AM Jan 11, at Elk Grove Park, the Dog Park parking lot. VST Draw: 10:15AM Jan 11, at Cosumnes College, parking lot F.

AWARDS: A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each passing dog, and a double-sided 5x7 picture frame.

**DOGS ON LEASH:** Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.


**ELIGIBILITY**: For the VST: all AKC registered dogs that have earned a TD, TDU, or TDX title are eligible to enter this test. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the VST title. Dogs who have not earned the VST title will be given priority for entry in the VST. For the TDU: all AKC registered dogs at least six (6) months of age that are eligible for entry and that meet AKC eligibility requirements are eligible to enter this test. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the titles TD, TDU, TDX or VST. Dogs not holding any tracking title will be given priority for entry in the TDU. Dogs not holding any tracking title must include a judge's certification with their entry.

**BITCHES IN SEASON**: Bitches in season may participate. Notify Test Secretary as soon as you arrive if your bitch is in season.

DOGS IN VEHICLES: Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the sponsoring club for disciplinary action. All persons attending this test hereby waive any claim for damages against RBTF or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

**RISK:** The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. RBTF assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person; theft of personal property; theft, injury or death of any animal; or any loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site or in transit to/from the site.

**EXCHANGE OF TRACKS**: If the limit for entries is not reached in either the TDU or VST test IN THE PREFERRED BREED OF TERVUREN and the other is exceeded, the number of tracks offered may be exchanged on the basis of two (2) TDU tracks for one (1) VST track. Further, if the limit for entries is not reached in either the TDU or VST test for NON-TERVUREN and the other is exceeded, the number of tracks offered may be exchanged on the basis of two (2) TDU tracks for one (1) VST track.





# TDU - DIRECTIONS TO ELK GROVE REGIONAL PARK:

From Highway 99S coming from Sacramento- Exit Elk Grove Blvd. Turn left onto Elk Grove Blvd. From Highway 99N coming from Stockton - Exit Elk Grove Blvd. Turn left onto E. Stockton Blvd. Turn right onto Elk Grove Blvd. From Elk Grove Blvd: Turn right onto Elk Grove-Florin Road. Turn right at Gate 1, Main Entrance, to enter Elk Grove Regional Park. Follow park signs to the Dog Park which will be on the right. Test HQ is in the Dog Park parking lot, at the end of the parking lot where the restrooms are, opposite of the fenced dog run area.

- No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor
  has participated in a training session taught by that judge within ten (10) days
  prior to the date of the event (Chap 1, Section 12, paragraph 8).
- People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past 10 days, they
  have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks
  they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog
  has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate
  family of the dog's handler. The judges will determine the order in which
  the tracks are run and the number of each track. (Chap 2, Section 9,
  paragraph 4).
